













You'll be amazed at the collection of artifacts from America's Secret History at the CIA Museum.

Located down the well-guarded CIA headquarters in Langley, VA.



The CIA Museum houses over 3,500 pcs of intelligence history. From spy heirlooms and weaponry to a model of Osama bin Laden's compound used to plan the successful assault by United States Navy Seals.





The CIA's office of Research and Development designed the first drone in the 1970s. The "insectothoper" was used to advance intelligence collection with miniaturized platforms.

Satellites were able to take photos from hundreds of miles above the earth, air crafts from tens of thousands of feet, but CIA pigeons mounted with a miniature camera could gather intelligence from hundreds of feet completely undetected.
