

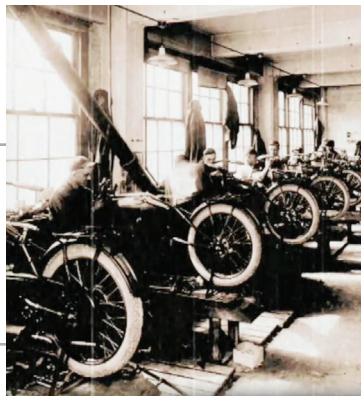

Early motorcycles were assembled by hand in the Milwaukee, Wisconsin factory.

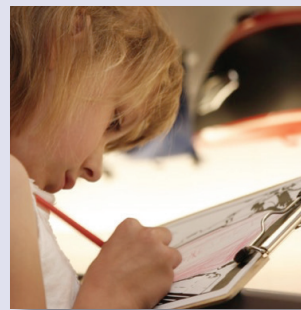
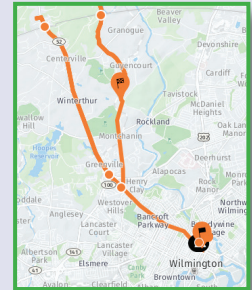


## Xtra Fun, Xtra Credit!
