The Wild Center, tucked into the Adirondack Forest is the place for you!

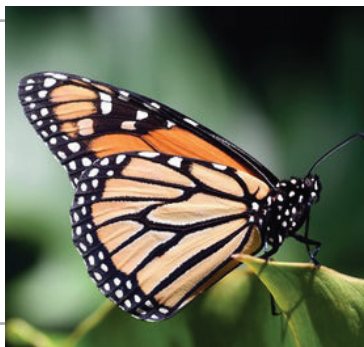
Did Ya KNOW?

The Adirondack Park is the biggest natural park in the lower 48 states. It can hold Yellowstone, Yosemite, Grand Canyon, Glacier and Great Smokey National Parks inside its borders!



The award-winning 'Wild Walk' gives you a chance to explore the Adirondacks from above the treetops, for a bird's eye view.

Each year, a special generation of Monarch Butterflies migrate 2,800 miles from a forest in Mexico to Northern locations, including the Adirondacks.

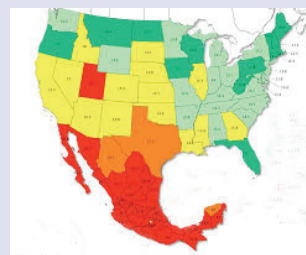
