*Materials Needed:*

- 2 cardboard tubes (we used toilet paper rolls)
- Camouflage patterned paper or fabric
- Glue
- Paper hole punch
- Piece of string or elastic



**Step 1**

Cut camouflage paper or fabric to cover both tubes

**Step 2**

Attach with glue, let dry

**Step 3**

Glue the 2 tubes together lengthwise, let dry

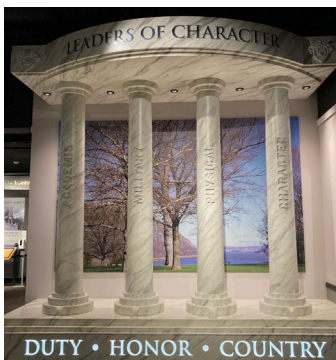


**Step 4**

Punch 1 hole at the bottom of each tube near edge

**Step 5**

Attach string through each hole and you're all set!
