Born in Spain, Dali was renowned for his technical painting skills. His **surrealistic works** are both dreamlike and realistic at the same time.

The Dali Museum features a **free-form glass bubble** known as the Enigma. A unique architectural feature made of 1,062 triangular pieces of glass. It stands 75' at it's tallest point.



Cutting edge technology let's you learn from the master himself! Artificial intelligence screens in the museum make you feel like you are actually **interacting with Salvador Dali**. He even takes a 'selfie' with you!
