#### More Talking Points:

- 1. What motivates you when you are working?
- 2. What makes you feel successful and accomplished in your work?

### Question 5

How would you feel if you worked on the tight SNL schedule every week?

#### More Talking Points:

- 1. What sort of work environment is best for you? Why?
- How do you handle the stress of upcoming deadlines?
