More Talking Points:

- Why is space travel important to the intelligence gathering process?
- 2. What types of information can be gathered from air and space?

Question 4

Despite new innovations being developed regularly, the CIA sometimes revisits old technologies. Can you name some of them?

More Talking Points:

- 1. What value can older ideas provide?
- 2. How do you use ideas and information from the past?

Communication between spies and case officers is very important and very risky. What techniques have been used to share information?

- 2. Can you think of new ways to transfer information? What are they?
