Question 1

Have you ever ridden on a train? Talk about your trip.

More Talking Points:

- 1. How is riding on a train different from other forms of transportation?
- 2. Would you want to take a train for a long trip? Why or why not?

Question 2

How has train travel developed over the years?

More Talking Points:

- 1. What type of trains are you familiar with?
- How have other transportation innovations influenced train travel?

Question 3

Why was transportation by train so impactful in developing and expanding the U.S.?

More Talking Points:

- How did trains impact the economy?
- 2. How did trains make travel easier?

Question 4

In the past, the signals for trains were a big industry. They helped protect people and direct trains. Why are signs and signals so important?

More Talking Points:

- How have railway signs and signals changes over the years?
- 2. What other important signs and signals do you see and use regularly? Why are they important?

Question 5

How did railway companies know where to lay railroad tracks?

More Talking Points:

- Why do you think tracks were laid the way they were?
- 2. Do you think there might have been a better way to decide where to put tracks? What might that be and why?
