









There's a good reason we often see these signs in museums. The MET Cloisters explains that it's natural to want to touch rare pieces of sculpture, but the oils and acids on our skin are very harmful to these works of art. Repeated touching damages the surface and alters the color of these sculptures. As you can see in the images above, the sculptures have lost much of their detail and color after repeated touching. So let's all heed. So let's all heed the signs and help preserve rare collections for future generations to enjoy.






The International SPY Museum in


