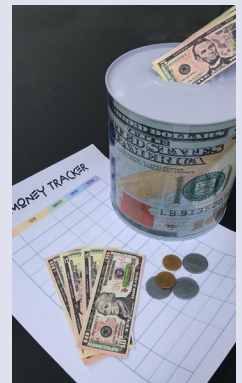
Make your own Funny Money!
