

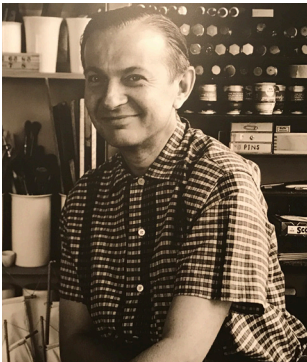

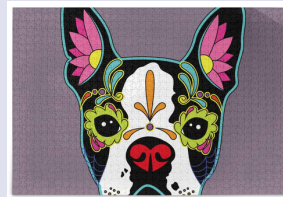
Folk Art for the Future!
